

High-speed Internet helps transform Stoneleigh Park into a centre of agricultural excellence

In August 2013, the management of Stoneleigh Park introduced an exclusive fibre campus network in a major capital investment programme to revitalise the site as an internationally-renowned centre for agriculture, rural business, science and innovation.
